## CBBC Apartment Rental

The Clarklake Beach and Boat Club apartment is available for members, their families, and guests who are visiting. The apartment is located above the clubhouse and has a dining room, living room, a kitchen space, and a newly remodeled bathroom. The two and half bedrooms

can sleep up to five people. The amenities include cable television, microwave, stove, oven, dishwasher, and refrigerator. The beach is only yards away. This apartment rents for \$400 a week during the summer season and \$100 a week between September and May. A 20% rent deposit is required to hold
